
Student Version of Child Safety Policy

INTRODUCTION

At Cana Catholic Primary School, we believe that all students have the right to feel and be safe. We provide a curriculum where a child's safety and wellbeing are of great importance.

If you feel unsafe or afraid at school, at home or anywhere, you need to tell a trusted adult.

Trusted adults are people you trust and can tell when you are worried, scared or unsafe.



Everyone has the right to be safe and be protected from unsafe behaviours.

No one should behave in a way that makes you feel unsafe, uncomfortable or afraid. This includes anyone in your family anyone at your school or anywhere else in the community.

PURPOSE

The staff at Cana Catholic Primary school have committed to keep children safe at all times, within our school area. This includes on excursions, at camp, online (the internet), and at other locations around the school.

Children will not be scared that something bad will happen to them whilst at school.

The staff and children have created a safety plan if students are feeling unsafe.



COMMITMENT TO CHILD SAFETY

All students at Cana Catholic Primary School have the right to feel safe and happy in the school grounds and during any school activity.

The staff are strongly committed to take action against any unsafe behavior.

RISK MANAGEMENT

Cana Catholic Primary School knows that it is important to keep our school safe.

The whole school community looks for problems or things that might be unsafe and then if there are any problems, we will fix them right away, eg broken glass in playground.



CODE OF CONDUCT

At Cana Catholic Primary School we have a code of conduct for staff, children, volunteers, Priests, families, and any workers who work on the school grounds.

This code of conduct shows everyone how to behave safely.

WHEN WE GET NEW STAFF, THEY NEED TRAINING

Staff at Cana Catholic Primary School need continuous training to make sure that they are following the rules and participating in safe behaviours at all times. These programs include First aid training, cybersafety, emergency evacuation procedures and reporting to our School Leaders.

At Cana Catholic Primary School the whole school community help the children understand that they have a right to feel safe and secure.
